Scripture that shows meaning or purpose behind things

Genesis 1:26-28	The FIRST COMMISSION was that of rulership over the earth.
Matthew 6:10	The WILL of God is to be done on earth, as it is in heaven.
Matthew 5:13-14	The FUNCTION of believers in Christ is to be the "salt of the earth".
Colossians 1:16-18	The PURPOSE for all things centers in Christ.
Matthew 28:18-20	The GREAT COMMISSION is still in place.
Rom 13:1-7; 1 Pet 2:13,13	Gov. purpose to Establish Justice

Worldview Component Descriptions

God's Nature: God is...

Scripture that is specifically designed to tell us characteristics of God's nature / His attributes / What kind of God He is /

Hebrews 1:3, Psalms 139	GOD is omnipotent, omniscient and omnipresent.
Psalms 83:18	GOD is sovereign over all things.
Romans 1:18-21, II Timothy 3:16,	GOD communicates with mankind.
I John 4:12	GOD is faultless in judgment, infinite in mercy.
Gen 1; Job 38:41	God is creative
Ezek 31:2, 7-9; Psa 96:5-7; Psa 27:3-5	God is beautiful
II Cor. 5:10; Deut 9:4,5	God holds nations accountable
Rom 13:1-7	God has established ruling authorities

Creation: God's created natural world...

Scripture that specifically points to when, where, how God made the world / universe

Colossians 1:16-17	ALL THINGS have been created and are sustained by God.
Psalms 24:1	THE REALM OF CREATION belongs entirely to God.
Colossians 1:16-17, I John 2:17	THE CREATED REALM includes physical and spiritual realities, as well as temporal and eternal realities.
Genesis 3-6	CREATION has been plagued by sin since the Fall of mankind.
John 3:16	THE CREATED REALM has not been forsaken by God, in spite of the Fall.
Genesis 1:1, Nehemiah 9:6, Psalm 90:2	God created the physical earth
Genesis 1:26, Psalm 115:16	God gave man dominion over earth
Genesis 2:16, Genesis 3:17-18	God sustains us from the earth

Moral Order: Our moral or behavioral responsibilities are...

Scripture that points toward right and wrong choices, behavior, ethics

Romans 6:23	MORAL ORDER, when violated, requires consequences.
Psalms 14:7	MORAL ORDER is clarified through biblical examples of good and evil.
Genesis 2:21-24, Romans 13:1-7	MORAL ORDER is upheld through family, church, state
I Tim 2:2; Rom 13:13; I thes 4:12; Prov 2:1ff	Honesty
Proverbs; Col 2:3	Respect for truth
I Chron 29:17; Genesis 39:7-12; I Kings 9:4, Luke 16:11	Integrity
Luke 12:15	Greed

Mankind: Man's role in God's plan

Scripture that focuses on man's responsibility and role

Genesis 1:26-28, 9:6	MAN AND WOMAN were specially created in the likeness and image of God.
Isaiah 53:6, Romans 5:12	PEOPLE are alienated from God through sin.
Romans 6, 7, 8	HUMANS are restored to a relationship with God through Christ.
Hebrews 9:27, John 3:16	ALL HUMANS experience physical death, followed by eternal fellowship with God.
I Cor. 6:1-19	Body temple of Holy Spirit (Responsibility of the physical body)
I Sam 25; Prov 3:8; 4; Isa 38; Lev 3:6-17	General Health of man (Responsibility of the physical body)
